





The Urban Learning Internship program (TULIP) has been launched in pursuance of the announcement made in the Union Budget 2020-21 by the Hon'ble Finance Minister under the theme 'Aspirational India' to start a program to provide internship opportunities to the youth in Urban Governance bodies.



Such a program, inter alia, has been considered necessary to reap the benefits of India's demographic dividend in its efforts towards nation-building and is mutually beneficial to all urban Governance bodies through the infusion of fresh ideas and energy with the engagement of youth in co-creation of solutions for solving India's urban challenges. Alongside which, it provides a platform for the youth or the future leaders of the nation to participate in the local governance structure.

More importantly, it's furthering our endeavours to boost community partnership and Government-Academia-Industry-Civil Society linkages. TULIP is a programme for all, a synergy between government and youth, creating space for an informed opinion.






State Distribution

To fulfill the dream of our Hon. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi of Swachh and successful Amarnath Yatra, this year special attention was given to make this holy yatra grand and remarkable. With the tireless efforts of Lt. Governor Shri Manoj Sinha, administration, Shrine Board and other related agencies, Amarnath Yatra 2022 was first time ever, SWACHH YATRA.

To achieve this, SBM (U) this time 1037 extra toilets, 456 extra urinals, 247 new bath stations, 999 Dustbins in market & yatra camps, langars, 1080 sanitation workers and strong monitoring mechanism was adopted.

At the field all sanitation activities were monitored by 187 Swachh-Tulip Interns. TULIP interns were hired through an online portal after which they were briefed about their roles and responsibilities during the yatra. They were divided into teams in each campsite where the attendance was regularly monitored through GEOFENCING BASED MOBILE APP. All toilets were QR CODED and the interns scanned the QR code (video) and real-time feedback was received at the Mission Directorate which helped to ensure continuous monitoring. Also, regular FEEDBACK was taken from yatris at every camps and Langars. A total of 2373 FEEDBACKS were submitted by the interns during the yatra.

It also generated a local talent pool who gained expertise on Swachhata. An online survey was conducted by the SBM(U) Mission Directorate where most of the Tulip interns were happy to be a part of this Exercise and it really created an impact in the field.






