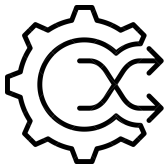
## The Beginning !

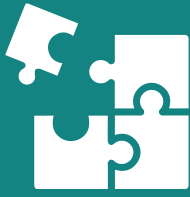

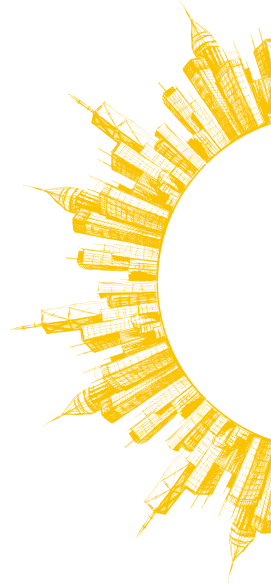

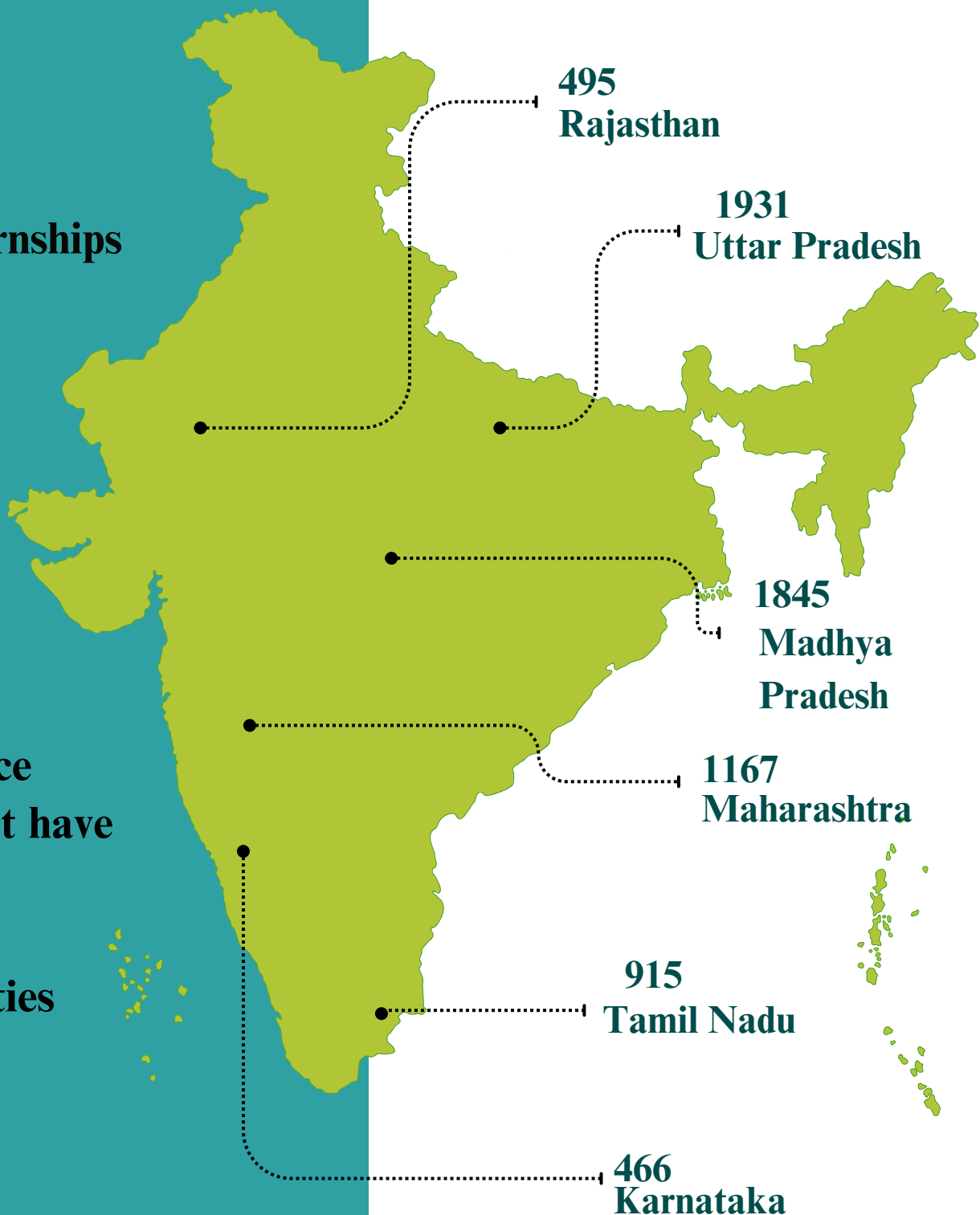

# TULIP and Smart Cities Mission

## A JOURNEY



The seed of TULIP, The Urban Learning Internship Program, was sown in **February 2020**, when the finance minister emphasized **creating internships for engineering graduates** in an annual budget session. A rigorous preparation for building such a platform was completed in just 45 days amid the world's most extensive lockdown. The entire program was handled online by interns and Smart Cities Mission fellows.

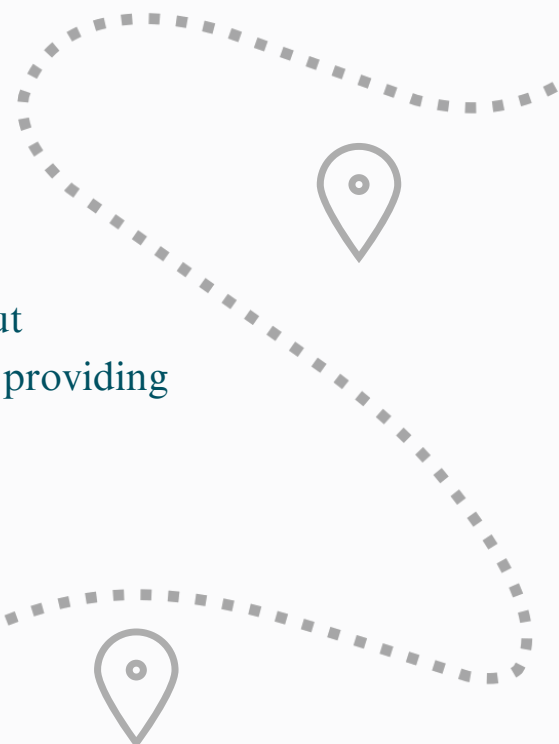
On June 4, 2020, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs and The Ministry of Education jointly launched TULIP for engineering graduates; however, eventually, the doors to this golden opportunity opened for all graduates when it was launched into the Smart cities. With the help of the Smart Cities Mission, TULIP has been designed for the professional landscape existing at various urban governance bodies.

**Tamil Nadu became the first state to implement this initiative**, with other states following. As the program gained popularity among cities and attracted students from different regions of the country, this transformative program was included in the formal ranking system of the Smart Cities Mission, where cities providing TULIP internships were given 5 points.

During TULIP's **second year**, the country struggled with the 2nd wave of COVID-19, which was alarming and deadly. However, despite being a newbie program, **TULIP became a resourceful support, providing paramedics and doctors** as interns in Smart Cities and across the country.

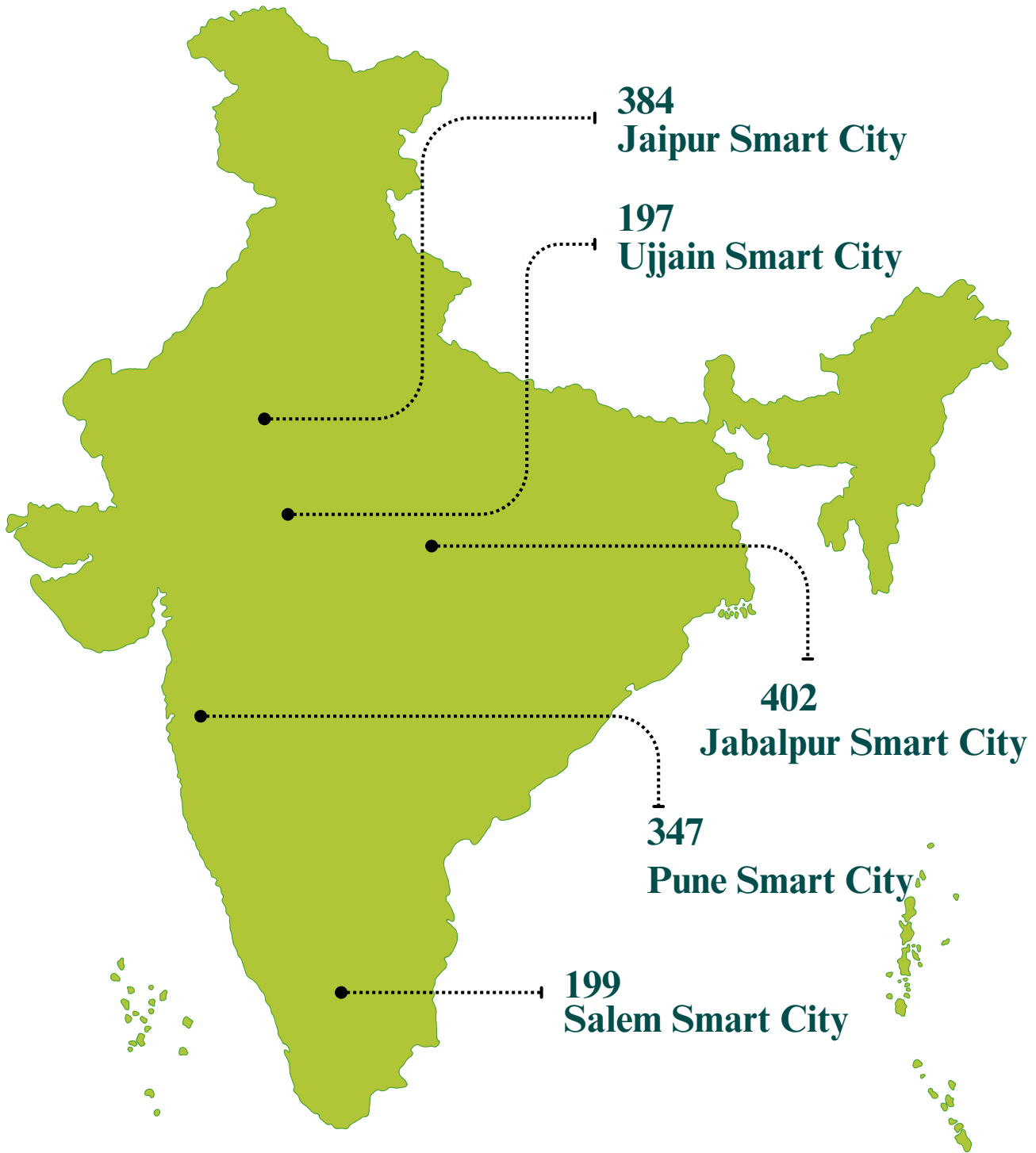
From September 2021 to February 2022, TULIP grabbed a fast pace of growth, realizing huge and sudden surges in postings and conversions across States.

# THE JOURNEY



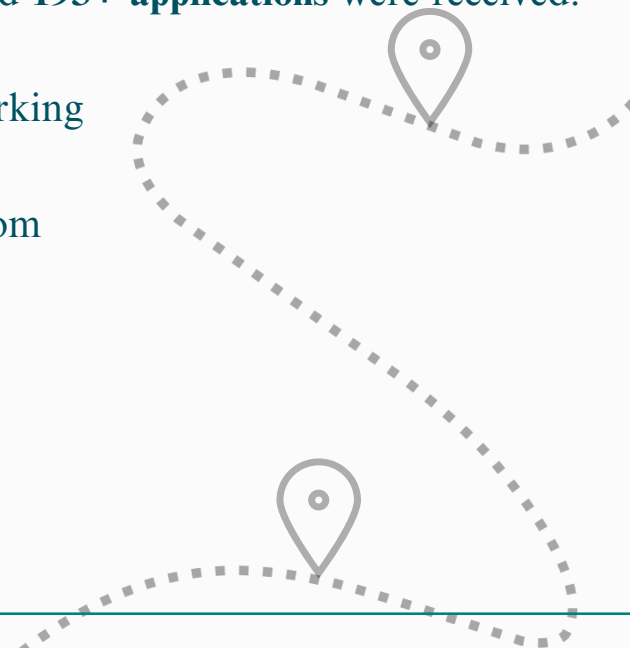
The National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) and Pradhan Mantri Street Vendors Atamnirbhar Nidhi (PMSVANidhi) are the flagship programs launched by the Government of India to **alleviate poverty and promote sustainable livelihood** opportunities in urban areas. Initiated in September 2013, NULM & PMSVANidhi focuses on empowering the urban poor, including the economically marginalized and vulnerable sections, by providing them with access to **skill development, employment opportunities, social security, and basic services**. Through a comprehensive and inclusive approach, NULM & PMSVANidhi seeks to enhance the quality of life and socio-economic status of millions of urban dwellers, fostering urban prosperity and inclusivity across the country.

Through the channel of TULIP, the young graduates got the opportunity to work for the NULM & PMSVANidhi as interns. During the **1st phase in March 2023, 30 vacancies** were posted for the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MOHUA), and **289 applications** were received. Despite having openings for 30 positions, **64 internships were offered** by looking at the number of applications received. After the completion of internships 38 interns were placed in MOHUA, whereas the remaining 26 interns were placed in the Urban Local Bodies in their respective states.

Through the first phase which took place recently, all the interns got placed and are currently employed, which is an achievement. The pattern of the **next phase** also began like the previous one, as **50 vacancies** were posted and **193+ applications** were received. Out of these 193+, 46 are given the offer letter.

In this phase hopefully, the interns offered will be working with the Ministry or the ULBs after the completion.

And we are looking forward to more participation from the youth in the future.

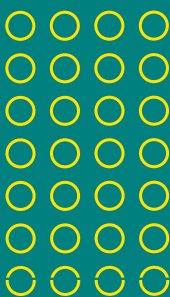

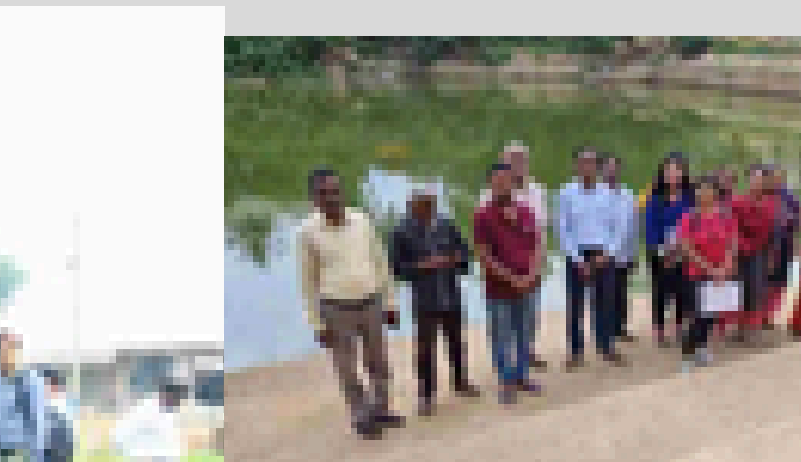
